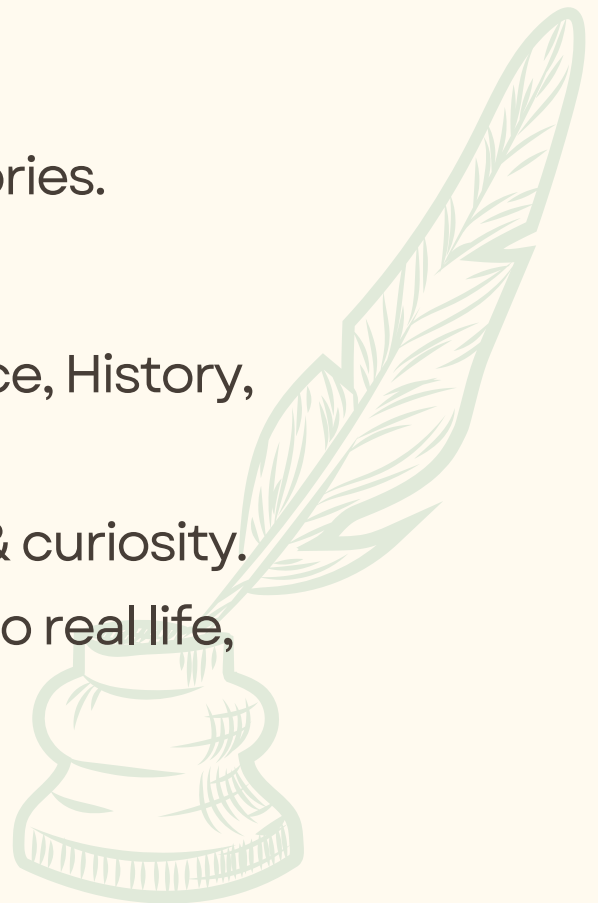

- Connects classroom learning to real life, values, and emotions.



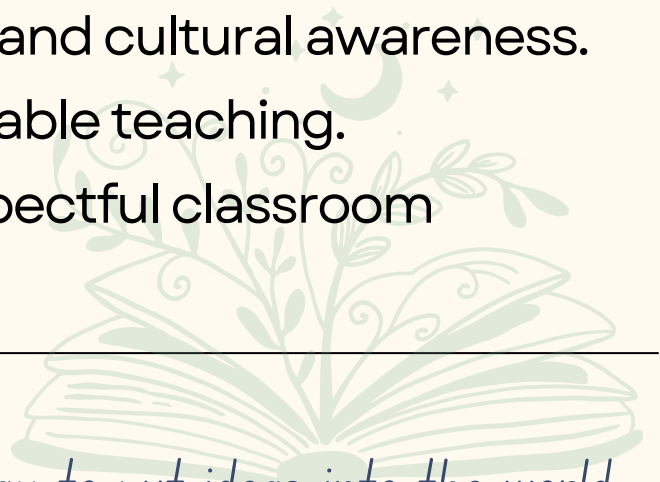
Practical Strategies
